

## Personal Equipment List

### Required

- Official Scout uniform(s) for your current Scouting position (Note: A complete uniform includes the official shirt; shorts, long pants {or switchbacks}, skirts, or culottes; socks; and belt {leather or web}. A neckerchief and slide will be provided.)
- Scout activity uniform(s) (Note: An activity uniform includes a Scout T-shirt or knit shirt and Scout shorts, long pants, skirts, or culottes.)
- Shoes or boots (not white, please)
- Windbreaker or jacket
- Rain gear (poncho or rain suit)
- Underwear & extra socks
- Handkerchiefs
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Flashlight with spare batteries and bulb
- Pocketknife or multiple tool — type knife (no fixed-blade knives)
- Medication in labeled containers
- Toiletries
- Towels and washcloths
- Sleeping bag or blankets
- Pens, pencils, pocket notebook
- Canteen or water bottle
- Handbook for your Scouting program
- Backpack/Sports Bag for carrying your gear
- Tent (borrow or share)
- Ground pad, air mattress, or cot

### Optional

- Pillow
- Change of shoes
- Moccasins or camp slippers
- Mosquito netting
- Shower footwear
- Sunglasses
- Religious book(s)
- Books of camp songs, skits, etc.
- Camera and film

- One activity T-shirt
- One ball-style cap
- Bag for notebook & misc.
